Physical Eligibility:

1. In good health;
2. Minimum height of 163 cm (Men) and 157 cm (Women) without footwear;
3. Minimum body weight of 50 kg (Men) and 48 kg (Women);
4. Body Mass Index (BMI) must be within the range of 19 to 26;
5. Chest measurement must be at least 81 cm (normal) and 86 cm when expanded (Men only);
6. Must pass a vision test for both left and right eyes separately, with a minimum visual acuity of V/6/9, with or without corrective aids (glasses or contact lenses).
